MY STORY

I had the privilege of growing up in a Christian home & hearing the gospel from a young age, unlike so many in my country. God saved me & has given me a deep desire to share the gospel with those who have never heard, in the schemes of Scotland.

I moved to Niddrie, Edinburgh in 2015 where I did an internship with 20schemes, with a focus on Women's Ministry. During that year a small team & I started doing outreach in two close-by schemes - Bingham & Magdalene. I moved into Magdalene in 2017 and a church was planted there in 2020. I served as a Women's Gospel Worker & & helped establish a long term women's ministry in this church. In 2022 we took on an indigenous lady, saved from the scheme, who I had the joy of mentoring.

In 2024 the Lord led me west to a working class town called Kilmarnock. I am working alongside Kilmarnock Baptist Church. This church has been around for years in this town but has seen significant growth in the last few years, with a number from the schemes getting saved.

Also in 2024 the church relocated (due to building issues) to Shortlees, a scheme in the south of the town. These scheme hasn't had a church presence for over 10 years so we are excited to be here. The Lord has provided a house for me in the Shortlees and I am praying we are a gospel light in this spiritually dark place.
